Transitions Home provides a safe, nurturing environment in which teen mothers and their babies can become a self-sufficient and healthy family. Day care is provided on site to allow residents to attend high school and/or work. The mothers and their children may stay in the program for up to two years. Miss Teddy moved into our Transitions home about 18 months ago, while pregnant with Alex. Alex has been healthy since birth, and is now an active 14-month old toddler who is meeting all of the developmental milestones.
